

# How to use the RAMADAN CHATTERBOX

1. Print, cut out and fold the Ramadan Chatterbox.
2. Gather players and pick one person to operate the chatterbox and one to play.
3. Have the player choose one of the top four squares. The operator spells the character name while opening and closing the chatterbox for each letter.
4. Player selects a number. The operator counts out loud while opening and closing the chatterbox for each count.
5. Player selects a number. The operator asks the question under the number and opens the flap for the answer.
6. The player then becomes the operator. Rotate play until each person has a turn.
7. You can also use the Ramadan Chatterbox on your own!

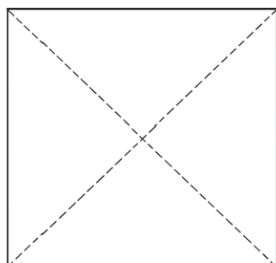

# How to fold a RAMADAN CHATTERBOX

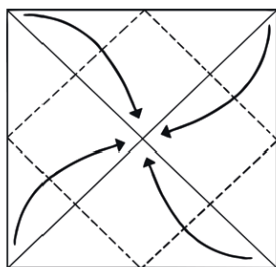
## Instructions

①



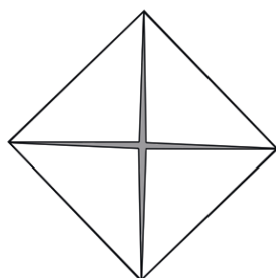
With pictures face down, fold on both diagonal lines. Unfold.

②



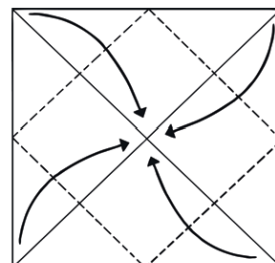
Fold all four corners to the centre.

③



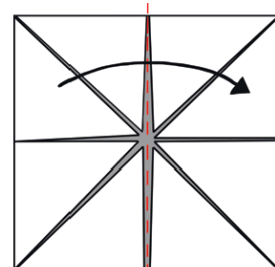
Turn paper over.

④



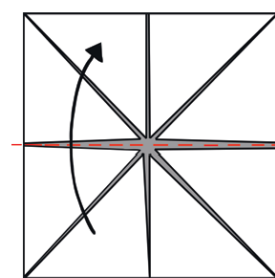
Once again, fold all corners to the centre.

⑤



Fold paper in half and unfold.

⑥



Fold in half from top to bottom. Do not unfold.

⑦



Slide thumbs and forefingers under the squares and move the Ramadan Chatterbox back and forth to play.
